- > Cloud API and UI Does not require updating to latest Cloud Agent

 - Users can now select Test Pattern Generator (TPG) as their Audio source

Improvements and General Maintenance

- > Cloud API and UI Does not require updating to latest Cloud Agent
 - Docker container privileged mode
 - When creating a Docker container via either the Cloud UI or API, users can now enable privileged mode
 - Read more here about the security considerations when using privileged mode for a container: Container is running in privileged mode
 - VESA resolutions
 - Users with the appropriate licenses can now select 1440p and 1200p as input and encoding scaling resolutions
 - Org management changes
 - Only Videon admins are now able to create, delete, and rename organizations
 - Users must submit support requests to have a Videon admin assist in creating, deleting, or renaming an org

Fixes

- > Cloud API Does not require updating to latest Cloud Agent
 - Fixed the Advanced Container Create dialog not sending all of the entered container parameters
 - HTTP Push outputs now auto-populate DASH time service by default to avoid configuration issues
 - Removed the Processor State dialog for Max, simply showing the status based on GPU throttling
